Course cost: £150 for non-members / £135 for BASICS Scotland members

This is an online course aimed at emergency medicine professionals and will run for 14 weeks. A new lesson is released every week and each weekly lesson will contain a pre-recorded presentation by our specialty doctor in emergency medicine Karyn Webster. Case study discussion weeks will take place after every three lessons and a live presentation will be scheduled to take place during that week. Everyone is encouraged to attend this live session as it will be your opportunity to interact with Karyn, ask questions, and submit your own case studies for discussion in relation to topics from the previous three lessons. Lessons will still be released weekly through the BASICS Scotland E-learning site and participants will be notified through email when new content is available to view. Live sessions will be delivered through Adobe Connect and instructions for getting this set up will be provided.
